



## HKFC Netball Player's Code of Conduct

### Expectations of Players

All club members are expected to represent the club proudly and not bring the Club or the game into disrepute. This includes playing in the correct uniform and playing fair and hard.

- 1) Attend all trainings and matches in game ready mode with a minimum of 80% attendance for ALL team members.
- 2) Be punctual to all trainings and games.
- 3) All players are required to inform your team's coach, captain and vice-captain of any intended absences or lateness from training and games well in advance, or as soon as you are informed.
- 4) If you are injured or pregnant, your attendance is still expected and you can take on other roles to help your team.
- 5) Contribute to the team by conducting your nominated umpiring duties, desk duties and match reporting throughout the season.
- 6) Be familiar with the HKNA By-laws and league rules.
- 7) Treat all players as you would like to be treated yourself
- 8) Attend an umpiring course held by HKNA (if you are not already HKNA qualified)
- 9) Pay any umpiring fees (if your team opts to pay for an umpire)
- 10) Mandatory contribution of three (3) community club hours (for the entire season) to help the growing netball community and tasks of running the club.
  - a. Hours can be fulfilled by helping umpire or coach the junior/netta's, assisting with running of social or coaching events, helping with distribution of uniforms, providing articles for the website and/or facebook page, organizing your team socials etc.
  - b. Please communicate how you want to contribute your three (3) hours of service to your captains for reporting purposes.
- 11) Attend all social functions held by the Netball DSA as well as any inter-section events (4 per year) unless provided a valid reason and communicated in advance.
- 12) Attend all social functions organized by your team (2 per year) unless provided a valid reason and communicated in advance.

Failure to comply with Club expectations concerning behavior towards other players, HKNA officials, and the coach will result in:

- Removal from the court for a quarter, or the rest of the match at the discretion of the coach
- For repeated occurrences, your eligibility for the following Netball season may be revoked/reconsidered at the discretion of the Netball DSA committee
