Term One Welcome to the HKFC Junior Netball Academy 2015/16 Netball Season

Dear All,

On behalf of the Committee, welcome to the Hong Kong Football Club Junior Netball Academy. Listed below is some useful information about the Junior Netball Academy and what to expect in the season ahead.

TRAINING AND TOURNAMENTS

The HKFC Junior Academy train on Mondays at 6-7pm and Wednesdays at 5-6pm or 6-7pm. Training times are determined by the participants' age and court availability.

The HKFC Junior Academy netballers are eligible to compete in the HK Junior Netball League, which is officiated by the Hong Kong Netball Association (HKNA). The league is made up of two separate competitions:

1. Autumn Competition (October-December) played on Saturday afternoons in Kowloon
2. Spring Competition (February-April) played on Sunday mornings in Aberdeen

All information including dates, times and venues of games will be confirmed via email and posted on both the HKFC website www.hkfcnetball.com and the HKNA website www.netball.org.hk

NEW FOOTWEAR REQUIREMENTS

The HKFC have imposed strict rules on the types of footwear permitted in the Sports Hall. All players are required to adhere to the new footwear guidelines in the HKFC Sports Hall.

Footwear permitted:

- Clear soled Squash shoes
- White soled Basketball shoes
- Court specific Netball shoes (non-marking)

NO running shoes or cross trainers will be allowed. Players who do not have the correct footwear will not be allowed on court due to the HKFC restrictions.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE AND FEES

HKFC Junior Netball Academy fees are charged **per term**. For HKFC members the term fee includes coaching fees, competition fees, umpiring fees and a netball levy. Non-members have an additional cost for venue hire.

Please note that there has been an increase in fees for 2015/16 season due to increase the cost of team registration, umpiring fees and a new player registration fee, which the HKNA has imposed on clubs. The HKFC Committee has asked that we ensure that players who undertake to take part in our training program also play in the HKNA competition.

In addition to the above fees players participating the HKNA Junior Netball League will be required to purchase a HKFC playing kit. The Netta and 13s and under will need to purchase a HKFC Playing Vest for \$140 and 19s and under will need to purchase a HKFC dress for \$200.

Please note that this season we have a new kit, which also has the HKFC Netball DSA sponsor, printed on the kit. There is no kit required for 5 to 7 years group.

Fees will be charged to HKFC Member's account at the beginning of the term and for non-members payment can be settled by cash/cheque and this is due by the 2nd week of each term.

Fees cannot be refunded once charged.
